A thousand years of history take shape on the pages of this book as Barry Cunliffe recreates Rome itself—a world opening up, flourishing, and then collapsing. Along with the history of Rome's growth and dominion, Professor Cunliffe describes her changing political, social, and cultural institutions. But above all, he lets the Romans speak for themselves.

Featured among this volume's 1,000 illustrations, of which half are in full color, are superb photographs by former *Life* correspondent Brian Brake and by the internationally known photographer of artistic and historic sites, Leonard von Matt.
