



It will be an opportunity for you to see a varied program of the best professional theatre that Pennsylvania has to offer.

Theatre Association of Pennsylvania (TAP) is a non-profit association of theatre people, founded in 1968 to further the understanding, knowledge, and art of theatre in Pennsylvania. TAP is organized on a statewide basis of thirteen regions under regional directors. These regional units assure local attention and state-wide assistance to all theatre interests—professional, college, and university, community, and public school theatre organizations.



Last year the Penn Wood Players of Johnstown, Pa., finally found a home after fifteen years of drifting. They acquired an old vaudeville theatre, condemned by the state for demolition. A board member of the Penn Wood Players reported in a recent issue of THEATRE, PA., "Volunteers swarmed the place to put it back in operation: rebuilding the roof over the stage three stories up in the fly space, rewiring, cleaning out fifty years of filth, restoring plumbing and furnace. Rebuilding took some professional help as well, and there was the cost of new materials, but the community had faith. The effort succeeded and two musicals, a comedy, and a drama were mounted at the Arcadia last year."

The bills for construction are still coming due—but the theatre itself is gone, washed out by the Johnstown Flood of 1977.

In addition the Penn Wood Players lost almost all their possessions: power tools, lights and equipment, costumes, permanent sets, fly equipment, two sets of theatre curtains, etc. Two weeks later the Penn Wood Players mounted a show, U.S.O. style, and took it out to the homeless gathered in seven makeshift refugee centers.

These people deserve our respect as well as help. Consequently, the proceeds from our Saturday, October 15 performance of SUMMER and SMOKE will go to the Penn Wood Players. 
