## **GUEST ARTISTS**

Michael Foley has been involved in the world of professional dance for over 20 years and is considered a master teacher and choreographer in his field. He began his dancing career at Bates College under Marcy Plavin, where he received his B.A. in English and a minor in Spanish. During Mr. Foley's 10 years based in New York, he performed throughout the United States, Europe and Asia in the companies of over two dozen choreographers including Doug Elkins, Kevin Wynn, Sean Curran, Roberta Garrison, Joy Kellman, Donna Uchizono, Ruby Shang, Ben Munisteri and Eun Me Ahn. Mr. Foley received his MFA in Dance from the University of Washington in 2002 where he performed in the works of several of the 20th century's major choreographers. In 1994 he formed his own company, "Michael Foley Dance," touring the United States and Europe. Called "exuberant" and "hypnotic" by The New York Times, the Company received funding for new work and outreach programs.

He has served on the faculties of New World School of the Arts in Miami, The Amsterdam Dance Center, The Association of Professional Dancers in Ireland, Balettakademien in Stockholm and Bates College in Maine. Mr. Foley is currently an Associate Professor of Dance at the University of South Florida where he teaches modern dance technique, choreography, dance history, and directs a yearly study abroad program for American dancers in Paris. While at USF, he has organized major choreographic residencies, lectures and forums with modern dance icons both Bill T. Jones and Trisha Brown. He received the University's Outstanding Undergraduate Teaching Award in 2010.

**Barry Long** was the inaugural Samuel Williams Professor of Music at Bucknell University where he currently directs the jazz ensemble and teaches coursework in jazz and music theory. As a trumpeter and flugelhornist, he has studied and performed with such artists as Kenny Wheeler, Bob Brookmeyer, John Clayton, Eliane Elias, Benny Carter, and Jim McNeely; his compositional credits include honors from the Jazz Composers Alliance and commissions for Clark Terry and The Kandinsky Trio. Long was the first to receive a doctorate in jazz studies from the Eastman School of Music, has received grants from the NEH and the Brubeck Foundation, and his research has been published by Oxford, McFarland Press, and the IAJE. His current work includes a jazz appreciation text for Prentice Hall and a recording project inspired by spirituals and iconic Civil Rights photography.
