GUEST ARTIST BIOGRAPHIES

Melissa Bobick (choreographer) graduated with a degree in ballet and nutrition from Indiana University in Bloomington where she studied under Violette Verdy. From 2001 through 2007, Melissa danced with Eugene Ballet/Ballet Idaho. While there she was commissioned to choreograph three new works for the company, two of which were partially supported by grants from the Idaho Commission on the Arts. After being hired as a dancer for the National Choreographer's Initiative in Irvine, CA, Melissa was one of four dancers engaged by New York City Opera for their new production of *Cendrillon*, directed and choreographed by Renaud Doucet. She was also commissioned to set a new work on the ballet majors of Belhaven College. Melissa recently received her Master of Fine Arts degree in Choreography from Purchase College, Conservatory of Dance in New York. Melissa is an ABTè Affiliate Teacher and an ABTè Certified Teacher. While working in the New York metropolitan area, Melissa has been a faculty member at Ballet Hispanico, American Youth Dance Theater, The Dance Center of New Jersey, and Huntington Center for Performing Arts. Melissa will be choreographing a new work at the Eugene Ballet Company as a part of the 2012 Stravinsky Festival.

Nick Ross (choreographer) was born in Massachusetts but grew up in Colorado. Nick was a member of Peter Pucci Plus Dancers from 2002-2007, and has also worked with H.T. Chen and Dancers, Amy Marshall Dance Company, Jennifer Muller/The Works and Michael Mao Dance Company. He holds a BFA from the Conservatory of Dance at SUNY-Purchase. In 2003, Nick formed Nicholas Andre Dance, and he has since choreographed over 16 works for his company. His company has toured to Arizona, California, Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia and to St. Petersburg Russia. Nick has restaged and created new works for dance programs at SUNY-Purchase, Bucknell University, Manhattanville College Adelphi University, Richard Stockton College, Cedar Crest College, Arvada Civic Dance Theater, University of Northern Colorado, Houston School for the Performing and Visual Arts and Delaware Dance Company. Nick has served as an adjunct professor at Manhattanville College and Adelphi University and created and directed Adelphi's first Pre-College Summer Dance Program. Nick has also been a guest teacher at SUNY-Purchase. He has taught in New York City at the Joffrey Ballet School, Dance New Amsterdam, 92nd St Y/Harkness Dance Center, as well as in California, Colorado, Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Wisconsin, Virginia, and in Brazil and Russia. Mr. Ross is so excited to have had the chance to work with the dancers at Bucknell and wishes them the best success in the future.

Steven Draheim (lighting designer) is an Associate Professor of Lighting Design in the School of Drama at the University of Oklahoma, where he is the coordinator of the Design and Production Area.
