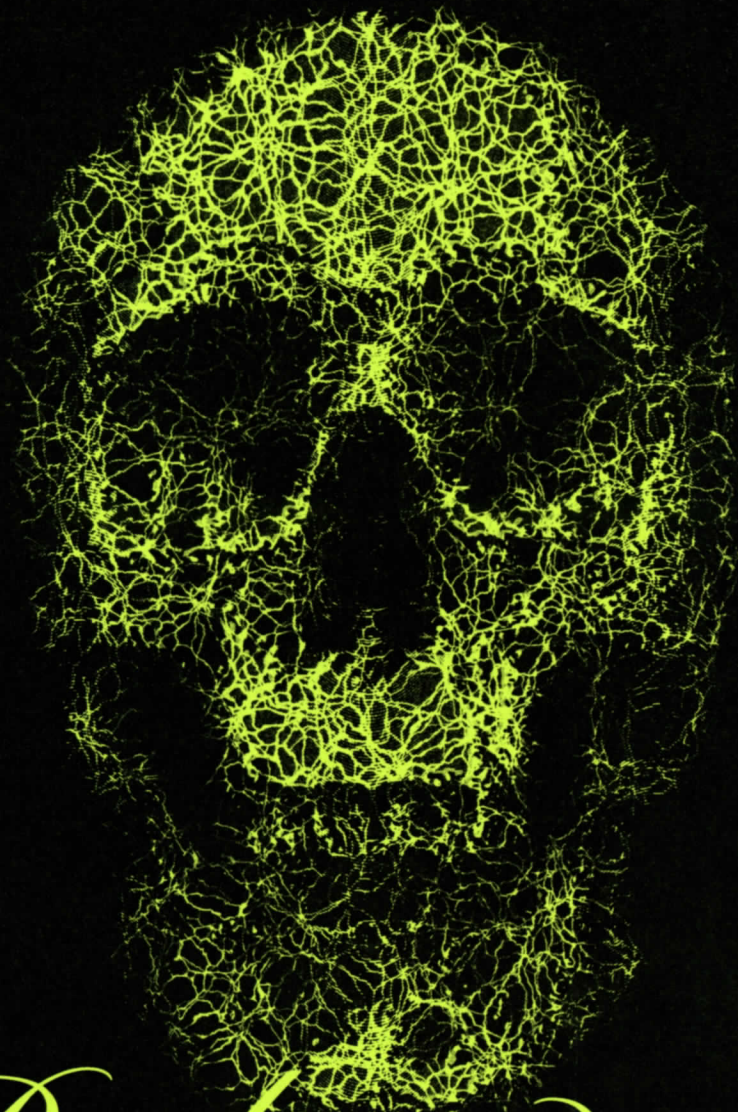

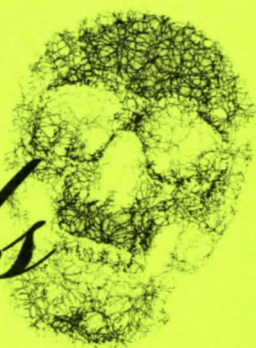

Director's Notes

When we first decided to produce *Radium Girls* as a part of our season, we were thrilled that so many departments and colleges across the university were interested in exploring the story with us. From 'Management 101', to 'Intro to Women and Gender Studies', to 'Imagining Sustainability' and 'Controversies in Biology'; we found this play had many stories to tell within it and could be understood through many different lenses.
